Breakout sessions provide the opportunity to contribute to the national winter maintenance dialogue and research agenda.

### Invitation to Vendors

The 6th National Winter Maintenance Peer Exchange will be held September 12-13, 2017 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, at the **DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel & Suites Pittsburgh – Downtown (1 Bigelow Square, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania)**. The technical program will include a keynote address and panel discussion on moving research to operations; briefings on the most current research in winter maintenance and RWIS technologies from the various groups, consortia, and other agencies involved in winter maintenance; and presentations of best practices and innovations from state DOT's.
