Expo becomes “road show”

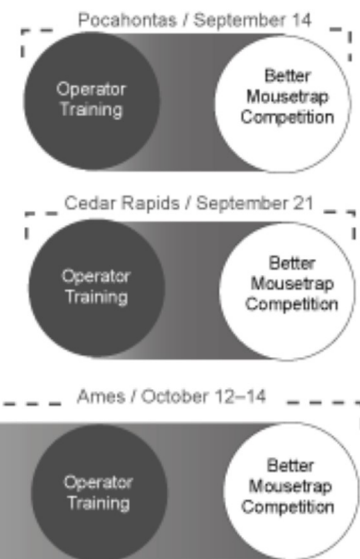
The annual Iowa Maintenance Training Expo has a new name and format. To make attendance more convenient for Iowa’s street and road workers, the new Iowa Streets and Roads Conference has been divided into modules, based on participant needs, and is going on the road.

Two events—equipment operator training and the Better Mousetrap competition—will be offered together at three locations on different dates:

- Pocahontas, September 14
- Cedar Rapids, September 21
- Ames, October 13

Two other events—the Iowa Secondary Roads Maintenance Supervisor Association (ISRMSA)/American Public Works Association (APWA) annual conference and the Snowplow and Motor Grader Rodeos—will be held only in conjunction with the Ames event, October 12–14.
